Federal Expenditures by CFDA Number Enterprise Report

Purpose: The purpose of this report is to provide assistance to agencies when preparing the Federal Financial Assistance Direct Disclosure Form. The intended users for this report are agencies that currently use or would like to use the CFDA field in AFRS.

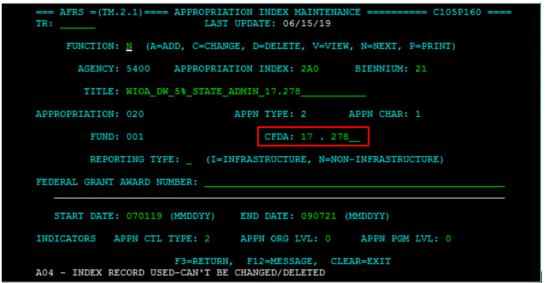
Report Criteria: Federal expenditure activity includes GL 6505, 6510, 6560 for expenditure authority types 2,3,8,U and N.

Recommended AFRS coding for CFDA number

CFDA number is in two locations in AFRS.

1. Appropriation Index Maintenance Table TM.2.1

The CFDA number is required for federal stimulus appropriation types and is optional for all other appropriation types. For more information about the Appropriation Index Maintenance Table refer to the AFRS Table Maintenance documentation.



2. Project Control Maintenance Table TM.2.4.

The CFDA field is required when Project Type = 1 (Federal Grants). It is optional for other project types. For more information about the Project Control Maintenance Table refer to the AFRS Table Maintenance documentation.

Recommended CFDA coding: For all projects funded by federal grants regardless of the project type, include the CFDA number on the Project Control Maintenance Table.




Report Information

Location: Financial Reports → Accounting → Federal



Report Parameters:

- 1. Coding Detail = No will display a summary report with the CFDA number and amount only. Coding Detail = Yes will display a detailed report with all coding detail (CFDA number, Account, EA Index, Project, etc.)
- 2. Expenditure with Blank CFDA = Yes will display all federal expenditures. Expenditure with Blank CFDA = No will display only federal expenditures that have an assigned CFDA number.



CFDA Fields: There are three CFDA number Fields on the report:

- 1. Project CFDA = CFDA number from the Project Control Maintenance
- 2. EA Index CFDA = CFDA number from Appropriation Index Maintenance
- 3. Master CFDA = Either the Project CFDA or the EA Index CFDA. If Project CFDA does not match EA Index CFDA, the report will display ****** and the agency should research and correct the conflicting information.

Fiscal Year-End Reporting

If all federal grants were assigned a CFDA number on the Appropriation Index Maintenance Table/Project Control Maintenance Table and expenditures were properly coded to the EA Index/project, then at fiscal year-end the Federal Expenditures by CFDA Number report can be used to determine the amounts to report on the Federal Financial Assistance Direct Disclosure Form.

In the example below, CFDA 17.207 and 17.225 on the disclosure forms tie directly to the Federal Expenditure by CFDA Number report, but the other CFDA numbers do not.

The expenditures reported under "******" in the Master CFDA column include all amounts that have a conflict between the CFDA numbers on the Appropriation Index Maintenance and the Project Control Maintenance Screens. If the Master CFDA number is blank on the report, it indicates that the amounts recorded do not have a CFDA number assigned. In both cases, the agency should review the detail report to identify the issues and make appropriate corrections.
