

ORDINANCE 07-01

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX PROPERTY FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Lind, Adams County, Washington, as follows, to-wit:

Section One: The Town of Lind hereby annexes the non-contiguous property described herewith that is presently owned by the Town of Lind to be used for municipal utility purposes pursuant to RCW 35.13.180.

Legal Description: That portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 17 North, Range 33, E.W.M., situate in the County of Adams, State of Washington, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Southwest Quarter; thence South 00 42'33" West along the West line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of 430.00 feet; thence South 89 22'52" East, a distance of 30.00 feet to a point on the East line of Neilson Road and the Northwest corner of Adams County Tax Parcel #558; thence South 00 42'33" West along said East line of Neilson Road, a distance of 150.00 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence South 89 17'27" East, a distance of 130.00 feet; thence South 00 42'33" West, a distance of 150.00 feet; thence North 89 17'27" West, a distance of 130.00 feet to a point on the East line of Neilson Road; thence North 00 42'33" East, a distance of 150 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Parcel No. 2-733-13-032-2458.

Section Two: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect after its passage and publication according to law.
