AN ORDINANCE providing for the annexation of certain territory to the Town of Creston, Washington, and incorporation the same within the corporate limits thereof, providing the assumption of existing indebtedness, assigning zoning classifications and setting an effective date, and repealing Ordinance 2011-02.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the town of Creston as follows:

Whereas, a Petition for Annexation was made in writing a filed with the Town Council seeking annexation of the property described as:

The West 150 feet of the West 390 feet of the Southwest 438 feet of the East 1000 feet of the Southwest one-fourth of the Southeast one-fourth of Section 10 T 26, R 34. Also known as tax parcel #2634-010-000300.


Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Creston in a regularly scheduled session on the 15th day of October, 2014, reviewed the annexation petition and recommended approval of the Petition for Annexation and that the property be zoned residential.

Whereas, the annexation petition for the property described above is approved and the property is deemed annexed. The said property shall be taxed at the same general rate and on the same general basis as the property in the Town of Creston is assessed and taxed to pay for any presently outstanding indebtedness of the Town of Creston which has contracted prior hereto, or exist at the date of this annexation.


Whereas, a copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Lincoln County Assessor's office.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and publication as provided by law.



Robert Butzer, Pos #1




