

ORDINANCE NO. 430

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY
UTILIZED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

R E C I T A L S:

1. The City of Oakville maintains a watershed within the ordinary course of its municipal activities.

2. It is deemed necessary and appropriate to annex the property contained within said watershed to provide for appropriate regulation and protection.

3. The City of Oakville is a municipal corporation operating under the Optional Municipal Code and has the authority under R.C.W. 35A.14.300 to annex property for municipal purposes, whether contiguous or non-contiguous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKVILLE:

SECTION 1: That certain real property more fully described in Attachment Number 1 attached hereto and incorporated by this reference shall be and is hereby deemed to be held by the City for municipal purposes.

SECTION II: The property described in Attachment Number 1 shall be and is hereby annexed to the City of Oakville.

SECTION III: The annexation provided pursuant to the provisions of Section II shall take effect upon the first date allowed by law.


SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the fifth day following date of publication, whether of the Ordinance or a Synopsis thereof.


