Else if	Non-Violent Score is greater than or equal to 50	Then	High Property
Else if	Felony Score is greater than or equal to 64	Then	High Drug
Else if	Non-Violent Score is greater than or equal to 38	Then	Moderate
Else if	Felony Score is less than 64	Then	Low
