The WCC has 50 crews (5 members and 1 supervisor) and 30 individual placement members located at project sites throughout the state. WCC members can take advantage of valuable networking opportunities through our collaboration with various governmental and non-profit organizations.

In addition to acquiring hands-on skills, members are offered excellent formal training opportunities, many of which result in a certification. Training courses include Wilderness Advanced First Aid and Wilderness First Responder, wetland delineation, wildland Firefighting/Red Card, Hazardous Materials Response and more.
