


## Cultural and Recreational Opportunities

Indicator 1: Increase Participation in Recreation and Cultural Activities

Measure d: Number of State Park Visitors by Calendar Year

### Description:

Washingtonians visit state parks for a variety of recreational activities: day use, overnight camping, boating, and others. The bulk of the visitors to Washington parks tend to be day-use visitors; as a result, much of the variability in the total number of visitors is because of changes in the number of day-use visits.
