



Indicator 8: Washington High Speed Phone Lines (DSL, Cable, Wireless)

Measure a: Washington High Speed Phone Lines (DSL, Cable, Wireless)

Description:

The number of high speed phone lines (DSL, cable, wireless) increased from 72 thousand in December 1999 to over 3.3 million in June 2008. As of December 2008, 61% of Washington households had fixed high-speed connections, compared to 60% nation-wide.
