



Indicator 1: Reduced Preventable Loss of Life, Injury, or Property

Measure d: Recidivism Rates for All Offenses

Description:

For purposes of this measure, recidivism is defined as a return within five years to a Washington State adult correctional facility resulting from a new conviction or parole violation by an offender who has either been discharged or paroled from such a facility.
