



Measure b: Percent of Local Jurisdiction that Have Current or Overdue Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and Supporting Plans 2008

Description:

State law requires local jurisdictions to develop emergency plans for the risks in their areas. Comprehensive plans need to be updated every four years.
