



Indicator 1: Decrease the Percentage of Individuals and Families Living in Poverty

Measure b: Percent of Adults with Disabilities Who Are Employed

Description:

Data for this indicator were derived from the Washington State Population Survey. "Disabled" here is defined as someone who answered affirmatively that he or she had (a) a condition limiting activities, (b) difficulty learning, remembering, or concentrating, (c) difficulty dressing, bathing, or getting around, (d) difficulty going outside the home, or (e) difficulty working at a job. The numerator is the number of disabled adults who were employed. The denominator is all disabled adults, not just those who are in the labor force (employed or unemployed).
