



Indicator 2: Increase the Percentage of Vulnerable Children and Adults Living in Permanent Families and Safe Home or Community Settings

Measure c: Percent of DDD Clients in Home Care and Community Settings Versus Institutional Settings

Description:

Percent of Division of Development Disabilities (DDD) clients placed in community settings and in institutional (RHC) settings. The denominator of this measure was restricted to DDD clients with paid services in 2009. Prior to this time it had been DDD eligible clients (whether receiving paid services or not). Results from FY 04 onward are shown under the new definition.
