RE: Contingency Plan for the Washington State Human Rights Commission (WSHRC)

The WSHRC does not meet any of the exemptions and has determined that it will suspend operations absent an approved budget on July 1, 2017.

The impacts of the shutdown:

Layoff notices went out to all WSHRC staff, management and commissioners on Thursday, June 22, 2017. They will return to work when a budget is approved.

The WSHRC will be unable to process complaints and people could miss the statute of limitation for filing. The WSHRC has advised the public to contact the following federal agencies during a shutdown:
