




There are ten regions in the 2008 Washington State Population Survey. The uninsurance rate for King County was compared to each of the other nine regions. Key findings are:
 1. Compared to children living in King County with family incomes at or below 250% of FPL, similar children living in North Puget and Pierce County were less likely to be uninsured
 2. Compared to children living in King County with family incomes above 250% of FPL, similar children living in West Balance were more likely to be uninsured
 3. Compared to all children living in King County, children living in West Balance were more likely to be uninsured.

There are ten regions in the 2008 Washington State Population Survey. The uninsurance rate for King County was compared to each of the other nine regions. Key findings are:

1. Compared to adults living in King County with family incomes at or below 200% FPL, similar adults living in Pierce County were significantly less likely to be uninsured.
2. Compared to adults living in King County with family incomes above 200% FPL, similar adults living in West Balance and Yakima/Tri-Cities were significantly more likely to be uninsured.
3. Compared to *all* adults living in King County, adults living in the West Balance, East Balance, and Yakima/Tri-Cities regions were significantly more likely to be uninsured.
