## POSITION DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

This position serves as the expert for applications development, support and enhancements for all development efforts for the Forecasting and Research Division of OFM. This position provides technical and organizational leadership in IT solutions delivery.

The successful candidate must possess advanced technical skills, business knowledge, and an understanding of the overall impact of this specialty to be trusted by management to independently deal with high-risk/high-profile initiatives that may impact significant/fundamental services.

This position works closely with the business owners who oversee the Forecasting and Research applications for OFM. The incumbent will have the ability to translate technological options into business terms and interact with customers to create technology solutions for mission-critical business problems. The position serves as a mentor, coach, and trainer to others. Some of the duties include:

### **Software/Application development and design tasks include:**

- Architects solutions and develops technology roadmaps for systems that have significant statewide or customer impact.
- Designs, develops, and implements solutions using Microsoft .NET technologies, Transact SQL, Angular JS, JavaScript, HTML and CSS.
- Administers/implements Team Foundation Server and Application Delivery Lifecycle Management (ADLM) automation.
- Resolves issues related to environment, platform, software, and hardware requirements.
- Participates in problem management to identify permanent solutions where workarounds were employed.
- Researches technical issues related to development environment, application platforms and security.
- Provides transfer of knowledge to other team members.
- Provides expert-level maintenance and operations developer support

### **Provides expert-level maintenance and operations developer support tasks include:**

- Participates in software release and infrastructure planning with WaTech and other service providers.
- Supports applications in ASP.NET / C#.net and Web Forms.
- Maintains existing .NET Framework-based applications including WinForms and console applications.
- Participates in reviewing existing business processes, recommending process improvement strategies, and presenting technical solutions to facilitate those improvements.
- Provides consultation and recommendations to business owners on strategic risks and trade-offs affecting their systems.
- Develops and implements standards and procedures.
- Product Consultation.

### **Product consultation tasks include:**

- Creates and presents cost/benefit analyses, requests for proposals, and evaluation of major systems.
- Makes proposals to business owners and senior management regarding implications of proposed plans.
