**SUBJECT:** SAAM Technical Correction – Subsection 85.52.40 (Investment pools)

The online version of Chapter 85, Accounting Procedures, in Washington's *State Administrative & Accounting Manual* (SAAM) has been revised.

In Subsection 85.52.40, we changed the definition of a 2a-7-like external investment pool in order to early implement GASB Statement No. 59, *Financial Instruments Omnibus*, for the Fiscal Year 2010 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report. This change is effective June 15, 2010.
