SUBJECT: Chapter 95: Federal Assistance Reporting

We have revised Chapter 95, Federal Assistance Reporting, of the state of Washington's *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM), effective **June 1, 2008**. This directive recaps the critical dates related to federal year-end reporting. Please replace the entire chapter in your policy manual. The online version of Chapter 95 is available at: <u>http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/95.htm</u>.

The key change in Section 95.10 is the addition of a new federal cluster, Transit Services Programs, composed of CFDA numbers 20.513, 20.516, and 20.521. This change reflects the modified federal audit cluster definitions included the March 2008 OMB A-133 *Compliance Supplement*, Part 5.

As required in Section 95.20, agencies are to electronically complete and submit their federal disclosure forms by **September 18, 2008.** The original signed Federal Assistance Certification and any required attachments are to be mailed to the following address by **December 8, 2008**:

Agencies are encouraged to reconcile federal reporting data by the end of Phase 2 (**September 11**, **2008**) so that the Agency Financial Reporting System (AFRS) reflects correct data for completing the federal forms.
