

ORDINANCE NO. 40-B

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO THE TOWN OF WILBUR FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILBUR:

Section 1. That the following described lands, presently owned by the town shall be annexed and included within the city limits of the Town of Wilbur for park and recreation purposes, in accordance with RCW 35.13.180.

The S 1/2 of the NE 1/4, Sec. 12 TWP. 26R. 32 EWM and that portion of Government Lot 3 and the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, bound on the North and East by old PSH No. 2 from its intersection with the Wilbur-Coulee Dam road - State Secondary Highway No. 4C. as it now exists, thence east to the west city limits of the Town of Wilbur, Washington, thence west along PSH No. 2 to present PSH 174 intersection, thence north along Highway 174 to the point of beginning, all in Lincoln County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
