

ORDINANCE NO. 718

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TONASKET,
WASHINGTON CORRECTING THE DESCRIPTION OF
THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TERRITORY ANNEXED
BY ORDINANCE NO. 576 AND SETTING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tonasket did annex the Gerhard Memorial Cemetery with the passage of Ordinance No. 576; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the necessity that annexation boundaries to be correct to avoid confusion and possible conflicts in the future.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONASKET,
WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Section of the beginning point of the description of a portion of the annexed territory referenced in Section 1 of Ordinances No. 576 which reads as follows:

“Beginning at a point on the South line of Section 14, Township 37 North, Range 27 E.W.M.”

is hereby corrected to read as follows:

“Beginning at a point on the South line of Section 4, Township 37 North, Range 27 E.W.M.”

Section 2. The distance of the fourth leg (line 7) of the metes and bounds description of a portion of the annexed territory referenced in Section 1 of Ordinances No. 576 which reads as follows:

“thence South 89°47' East 361/11 feet;”


is hereby corrected to read as follows:

“thence South 89°47' East 361.11 feet;”

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.




