

ORDINANCE NO. 405

Ordinance Annexing Contiguous Real Property
Owned by the Town

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coulee City
as follows:

The following described real property, which is owned by the
Town of Coulee City and which is contiguous to the Town of Coulee
City, is hereby annexed to the Town of Coulee City:

1. Government Lot One (1) in Section Three (3), Township
Twenty-four (24) North, Range Twenty-eight (28), E.W.M.,
Grant County, Washington. (AUDITOR FILE NO. 175892)


2. Beginning at a stake 100 feet north of the intersection
of the North line of Chelan Street and the East line of
McEntee's First Addition to Coulee City, said stake being
1484 feet west and 990 feet south of the Northeast corner
of Section 3, Township 24 North, Range 28 E.W.M., running
thence East 824 feet, thence South 824 feet, thence South
450 feet, thence West 400 feet, thence North 270 feet,
thence West 424 feet, thence North 180 feet to place of
beginning, containing approximately 6 acres of land, said
tract of land being within the Northeast Quarter of
Section 3, Township 24 North, Range 28 E.W.M., said land
containing therein those certain springs from which a
water supply for said Town of Coulee City is now being
obtained. (FILE NO. 41868)


