**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF
JURISDICTION OVER A PORTION OF COUNTY ROADS
"R" NW, 10.5 NW, 11 NW, AND "P" NW FROM GRANT
COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO THE CITY OF QUINCY,
WASHINGTON**

WHEREAS this Ordinance deals with a portion of County Roads "R" NW, 10.5 NW, 11 NW, and "P" NW described as follows (the "Roadways"):

1. A portion of County Road R-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 93025, from Mile Post 0.170 to Mile Post 0.530, Contained in Section 12, Township 20 North, Range 23 East, W.M., County, Washington.
2. A portion of County Road 10.5-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 32680, from Mile Post 0.927 to Mile Post 0.210. Contained in Section 12, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.
3. A portion of County Road 11-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 32780, from Mile Post 4.030 to Mile Post 3.207, Contained in Section 5, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.
4. A Portion of County Road 11-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 32780, from Mile Post 3.010 to Mile Post 1.510, Contained in Section 4, Township 20 North, Rang 24 and Section 3, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.
5. A Portion of County Road P-NW, also known as County Road Log Number ^{93035 (68)}~~36250~~, Mile Post 0.460 to Mile Post 1.070, Contained in Section 8, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.

WHEREAS RCW 39.33.010 authorizes the State of Washington and its municipalities and political subdivisions to transfer real property rights on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon;



Section 1. The City accepts the transfer of the Roadways from Grant County, Washington.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City of Quincy and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after passage and publication.



RESOLUTION NO. 2007- 132 -CC
JURISDICTION TRANSFER

Whereas, in accordance with RCW 39.33.010, Grant County, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, acting through its Board of Commissioners, recognizes the benefits of transferring jurisdiction of certain portions of five County Roads in the Quincy area as described below and declares its intentions to transfer title or control of Right-of-Way easements of real property to the City of Quincy, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington.

LEGAL DISCRPTION:

- 1) A portion of County Road R-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 93025, from Mile Post 0.170 to Mile Post 0.530, Contained in Section 12, Township 20 North, Range 23 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.
- 2) A portion of County Road 10.5-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 32680, from Mile Post 0.927 to Mile Post 0.210, Contained in Section 12, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.
- 3) A portion of County Road 11-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 32780, from Mile Post 4.030 to Mile Post 3.207, Contained in Section 5, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington
- 4) A portion of County Road 11-NW, also known as County Road Log Number 32780, from Mile Post 3.010 to Mile Post 1.510, Contained in Section 4, Township 20 North, Range 24 and Section 3, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.
- 5) A portion of County Road P-NW, also known as County Road Log Number ~~36250~~ ⁹³⁰³⁵ , from Mile Post 0.460 to Mile Post 1.070, Contained in Section 8, Township 20 North, Range 24 East, W.M., Grant County, Washington.

WHEREAS, Grant County Public Works and the City of Quincy have previously agreed to work towards the transfer of jurisdiction of portions of said roads, and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer recommends the Grant County Board of Commissioners proceed with the jurisdiction transfer as mutually agreed, per 39.33.010, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Grant County Board of Commissioners transfer jurisdiction of portions of 5 County Roads as described above to the City of Quincy to become effective upon the date the City of Quincy executes a resolution, accepting jurisdiction of said roads.
