

AN ORDINANCE: annexing certain real property to the Town of Zillah, Yakima County, Washington, as provided by Chapter 128 of Laws of Washington of 1945.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ZILLAH DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That on the 2nd day of July, 1951, there was received by the Town Council of the Town of Zillah and filed with the Town Clerk of said Town, a petition addressed to the Mayor and Town Council of said Town, praying that the boundaries of said Town be altered by including therein certain real property lying contiguous to the Town of Zillah, the legal description of which is set forth, below, said petition having been signed by all of the owners of said land and a Notice of said public hearing having been hereto fore published in the Yakima Valley Mirror, a newspaper of general circulation in said Town, and a notice having been posted in three public places and within the territory proposed for annexation, specifying July 30th, 1951 at 8:00 P.M. in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Zillah in the Town Hall of the Town of Zillah, Washington as the time and the place for hearing on said petition, and interested persons having been invited in said publication and notice to appear and voice approval or disapproval of the annexation.

Section 2. That the territory proposed by said petition to be annexed to said Town of Zillah is situate in the County of Yakima in the State of Washington, is contiguous, proximate and adjacent to the present corporate limits of said Town, and is particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the West line of Section 31, Township 11 North, Range 21, E.W.M., 710.7 feet North of the West quarter Corner of said section; thence North 89 deg. 49 min. East 682.4 feet; thence North 11 deg. 22 min. East 543.2 feet; thence North 27 deg. 22 min. East 188 feet more or less to the South right of way line of the County Road; thence West along said South right of way line to the West line of the Section; thence South along the said West line to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That the territory set forth in this ordinance and for which the petition for annexation was filed, should be and is hereby made a part of the Town of Zillah, Yakima County, Washington.

Section 4. No property within the limits of the annexed territory shall ever be taxed or assessed to pay any portion of any indebtedness of the Town contracted prior to or existing at the date of such annexation; nor shall any of the annexed property be released from any taxes or assessments levied against it for payment of outstanding bonds or warrants issued prior to said annexation.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
