

ORDINANCE NO. 6464

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, REVISING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY TO REMOVE KING COUNTY'S JURISDICTION OVER SOUTH 277<sup>TH</sup> STREET, PURSUANT TO RCW 35A.21.210

WHEREAS, The City Council annexed property on its northern boundary under Ordinance 2499 in November, 1970, which boundary was corrected in December 1970 under Ordinance 2511; and,

WHEREAS, the annexation left portions of S. 277<sup>th</sup> Street within the jurisdiction of King County; and,

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.21.210 provides a method for the City of Auburn and King County to modify the City's boundary to remove King County's jurisdiction of this portion of S. 277<sup>th</sup> Street and to convey that jurisdiction to the City of Auburn.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. The City of Auburn expresses its intent to include the full width of S. 277<sup>th</sup> Street, plus any associated rights-of-way, within the boundaries of the City of Auburn. A description of that portion of S. 277<sup>th</sup> Street that still remains within the boundaries and jurisdiction of King County is attached and incorporated as Exhibits A and B.

Section 2. Implementation. The Mayor is hereby authorized to implement such administrative procedures as may be necessary to carry out the directions of this legislation.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or portion of this ordinance, or the invalidity of the application

thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
