# AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF THAT CERTAIN TERRITORY LYING AND BEING CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF COLVILLE, IN STEVENS COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AS PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN (CITY)
