

An ordinance of the Town of Wilbur, Washington repealing Ordinance 491 annexing certain legally described property into the Town of Wilbur for municipal purposes; and providing for the effective date thereof.

WHEREAS, the Town of Wilbur owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility on property in the Northeast quarter of Section 12 of Township 26 North, Range 32 East, Willamette Meridian, Lincoln County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Town annexed said property by Ordinance 275, passed by the Town Council in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council passed Ordinance 491 purporting to annex said property for the operation of a wastewater treatment plant, unaware said property had already been annexed to the Town by Ordinance 275; now therefore

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILBUR DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 491 is hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall be full force and five (5) days from and after passage, approval and publication.
