

ORDINANCE NO. 777

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OROVILLE ANNEXING LAKE OSOYOOS VETERANS MEMORIAL STATE PARK FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND SETTING CONDITIONS FOR ITS FULLY EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by virtue of RCW 35A.14.300 to annex territory outside the city limits for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission is considering the transfer of Lake Osoyoos Veterans Memorial State Park to the City of Oroville; and

WHEREAS, in considering such transfers, said Commission has set forth in policy that it will lend priority to cities where state parks exist within the Urban Growth Area of a city, or within its incorporated boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City considers said Park to be within its urban growth area as indicated by its inclusion in its Comprehensive Plan but said Commission does not acknowledge such designated areas if not pursuant to the Washington Growth Management Act, a statute that the City of Oroville is not required to fully comply with due to the Okanogan County's present population; and

WHEREAS, the subject park is a part of the City's Parks and Recreation Plan designated Service Area, Comprehensive Water Plan Service Area, and exists immediately adjacent to the incorporated boundary of the City of Oroville.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to protect the economy of the greater Oroville area by taking control of the long-term viability of Lake Osoyoos Veterans Memorial State Park.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OROVILLE, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. All property described in Exhibit "A" and depicted in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein as though full set forth is hereby annexed and declared to be a part of the City of Oroville, and said property shall be included and embraced within the corporate limits of the City of Oroville.

Section 2. Upon its effective date, this ordinance shall be recorded in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Okanogan, State of Washington.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective:

- 1) from and after its passage by the City Council,
- 2) approval by the Mayor,
- 3) upon the date of legal transfer of said Park to the City, and,
- 4) finally, on the date after its publication as required by law.


