

## **ORDINANCE NO. 733**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TONASKET,  
WASHINGTON PROVIDING CLARITY TO THE  
BOUNDARIES OF THE TERRITORY ANNEXED BY  
ORDINANCE NO. 723 AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Tonasket did annex the Bonaparte and Mill Drive neighborhood with the passage of Ordinance No. 723 and recorded the same with the County Auditor File No. 3180010; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35A.14.410 provides that there are options in the right-of-way line of any public street, road, or highway, or any segment thereof, that may be used to define a part of a corporate boundary in an annexation proceeding provided the boundary runs from one edge to the other; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the necessity that annexation boundaries have clarity to avoid confusion and possible conflicts in the future.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONASKET,  
WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The segment of description of the territory annexed by Ordinances No. 723 on Page 6 of 9 of the recorded ordinance on lines twenty-one (21) through twenty-three (23) which reads:

“Thence, continuing along said Southerly line North 89°51’27” East along said Southerly section line to its intersection with the Northeasterly Right-of-Way line of State Route 20;

Is hereby revised to read:

“Thence, continuing in a Northeasterly direction perpendicular to the center-line of the Right-of-Way of State Route 20 to the Northeasterly Right-of-Way line of State Route 20;”

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.
