## Ordinance 493

AN ORDINANCE annexing a certain portion of Whitman County not hereto fore incorporated into a city or town, which is contiguous to the Town of Malden, designating the annexation for municipal purposes;

WHEREAS Gene S. Henning and Gwelda J. Henning, husband and wife, have transferred and sold the real property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, hereinafter referred to as the "Water Storage Property";

AND WHEREAS the Town of Malden has passed Resolution No. 2013-2, accepting the transfer of the Water Storage Property, providing consideration for the transfer of the Water Storage Property, and directing and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer to execute documents to effectuate such transfer:

AND WHEREAS the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer have executed such documents as are necessary to effectuate the transfer of the Water Storage Property;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Malden will use the Water Storage Property for municipal purposes;

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF MALDEN:

Section 1. That the City Council of the Town of Malden does hereby determine that the Water Storage Property is intended to be to be used for municipal purposes as Town water storage and, pursuant to such determination , the Water Storage Property, which is described in the attached Exhibit "A" is hereby annexed to and made part of the Town of Malden, as allowed by Section 35.13.180 of the revised Code of Washington.

Section 2. That the annexation of the territory described in Exhibit "A" shall become effective on and after the date of publication of this Ordinance, and that the territory shall, on that date, be subject to all the laws and ordinances of the Town of Malden now in force, or which may thereafter become enacted.

Section 3. That the proper officers of the Town are hereby directed to provide notice of this annexation to the state Office of Financial Management, as provided by law.
