ORDINANCE NO. <u>1616-04</u>

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON, THE MILTON INTERURBAN TRAIL LOCATED IN KING COUNTY, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE INTERURBAN/HYLEBOS TRAIL ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Milton wishes to annex that portion of the Interurban Trail now owned by the City and located within King County; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.14.300 allows that legislative bodies of code cities may by a majority vote annex territory outside the limits of such city whether contiguous or noncontiguous for any municipal purpose when such territory is owned by the city; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Milton and of King County that the interurban trail be protected, preserved, and maintained as a trail and open space for the public by the City of Milton; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.93.090 provides that change in the boundary of a city arising from the annexation of contiguous city owned property held for a public purpose shall be exempt from the requirement of a review by the boundary review board; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milton has complied with all statutory requirements, including those set forth in chapter 35A.14 RCW inclusive and chapter 36.93 RCW inclusive; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The following described property located in King County known as the Interurban Trail and now owned by the City of Milton is hereby annexed to the City of Milton, Washington:




