

ORDINANCE NO. 339

AN ORDINANCE, ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE TOWN OF PATEROS PURSUANT TO R.C.W. 35.13.180 FOR A MUNICIPAL PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PATEROS:

SECTION 1: That the following lands in the County of Okanogan, State of Washington, to-wit:

Gov't. Lot 3, and that part of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter lying East of the State Highway (formerly State Highway No. 10) in Section 12, Township 29 North, Range 23 EWM,

which are entirely owned by the Town of Pateros and which have been and are continuing to be used by said Town of Pateros for municipal purposes, to-wit: waste disposal, shall be and are hereby annexed to said Town of Pateros pursuant to R.C.W. 35.13.180.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the publication of this Ordinance, and the boundaries of the Town are hereby altered to include the same, and said lands shall hereinafter be subject to all Ordinances of the said Town.
