Purpose:

Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5931 (Reorganizing and streamlining central service functions, powers, and duties of state government) removed the requirement which allowed employees to participate in the statewide return-to-work initiative program. As a result, rules that addressed this program were repealed. WACs 357-46-095(3) and 357-19-505, which reference the return-to-work initiative program, were inadvertently missed. This proposal repeals WAC 357-19-505 and amends WAC 357-46-095 to remove references to the return-to-work initiative.

In addition, this proposal amends WAC 357-46-095(3) and WAC 357-13-090 to allow employees who are reallocated to a class with a lower salary range maximum to be placed in the General Government Transition Pool (GGTP).
