Members are intimately involved in all aspects of the Master Home Environmentalist<sup>®</sup> Program, training volunteers in indoor air quality issues, performing home assessments, entering resident's information into the database, tracking volunteer activities and hours, answering environmental health questions from the public, updating fact sheets, attending health fairs and making presentations. CLEARCorps of Washington serves any and all individuals and communities with a focus on those most susceptible to environmental health risks.
