AmeriCorps members will improve the natural environment of the Puget Sound Region - primarily in King County - by completing environmental restoration projects in partnership with community groups, government agencies, businesses and nonprofit organizations. Members will also lead community volunteer events. King County will benefit with a legacy of restored fisheries and upland habitat; thousands of native trees, shrubs and wetland emergents planted; healthier open green spaces and an improved sense of community. The majority of days are spent working outdoors in all weather conditions and requires the ability to do repetitive tasks and lifting of over 25 pounds. Some overnight camping is involved. Field work includes weeding, planting, trail construction, trail maintenance, stream and wetland work, and maintaining tools and equipment. Program includes one to two days of education per month as well as the opportunity to work with others from around the United States and the world.
