

Federal Way Public Schools (A Partner of the Washington Service Corps)

AmeriCorps members serving in the Federal Way Public Schools will address the need for literacy and math tutoring at every grade level while serving those students who are at risk academically. Through the use of tested tutoring strategies and research-based curricula, members will be well-trained to meet the needs of individual students. Twenty-eight AmeriCorps members will provide tutoring in 23 elementary schools, helping students to build strong reading and math skills to support their continued achievement in school. Forty-two AmeriCorps members will serve in seven middle schools and five high schools to provide tutoring interventions that will help students pass the MSP and HSPE and graduate from high school. In addition, members will serve as AmeriCorps AVID Academic Coaches at the secondary level in order to prepare first-generation, low-income, and other historically underserved groups of students for college acceptance by running biweekly Formal Tutorials in every AVID elective offered in the school district.

Members receive Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training. In addition, team members will participate in approximately 10 service projects to model an ethic of service in the Federal Way community.
