

## **Habitat for Humanity East King County (A Partner of the Washington Service Corps)**

Habitat for Humanity East King County (EKC) provides AmeriCorps service opportunities for people of diverse ages and backgrounds. During a term of service, 15 members work together to help make safe, affordable housing a reality for families in need.

Habitat for Humanity EKC invites people from all walks of life to work together in partnership, building houses with families in need. Habitat has built more than 250,000 houses around the world, providing more than 1 million people in more than 3,000 communities with safe, decent, affordable shelter.

The primary role of the Habitat for Humanity EKC AmeriCorps Team is to coordinate and lead crews of volunteers and Habitat homeowners on the jobsite in building new homes or rehabilitating houses for Habitat families. Additionally, AmeriCorps members recruit and schedule volunteers, organize and facilitate special events, and support Habitat families who are working towards homeownership. Previous construction experience, community service, and leadership experience is helpful but not required for acceptance.
