Literacy*AmeriCorps is part of AmeriCorps, a national service program modeled after the Peace Corps, and sponsored through the generous support of the King County Library System. Members serve for one year, teaching fundamental literacy skills to adults and families in Seattle and King County. Literacy*AmeriCorps sites range from libraries and colleges to multi-service day programs and jails. Each service site offers a literacy program promoting adult or family literacy. Since 1994, Literacy*AmeriCorps members have served thousands of adult learners by teaching and tutoring English as a Second Language (ESL), adult basic skills, family literacy, GED-prep, computer literacy, naturalization, and vocational literacy. Literacy*AmeriCorps members have also coordinated successful volunteer programs, established strong community partnerships, and increased awareness of literacy needs in Seattle and surrounding King County.
