The mission of the Regional Service Corps (RSC) is two-fold: 1) meet community needs today, and 2) develop leaders for tomorrow. RSC manages a regional network of projects, which address the areas of literacy and academic success, youth development, and public safety. The program has a strong leadership enhancement component: Training is high caliber, team-based, and largely experiential; many graduates say it was a challenge that they never regret having met. Beyond training, members are encouraged to develop educational presentations and signature projects that inform and engage others. When not serving at their primary sites, RSC members get involved in a variety of community projects that address diverse human needs and environmental concerns. The program seeks applications from those who are 18 or older and have a strong desire to make a difference in the lives of others while enhancing their own ability to lead in the future.
