In partnership with the Workforce Development Council, the Regional Service Corps will co-enroll members who are also participants in the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Out-of-School Youth (OSY) program. These members will serve in a variety of positions at local non-profits that address diverse community needs.

The program seeks applications from those who plan to enroll, or are already enrolled in the WIA-OSY program and have a strong desire to make a difference in the lives of others while enhancing their own ability to lead in the future.
