

## **VISTA Individual Placement Program (Washington Service Corps)**

The VISTA Individual Placement program is a statewide program run by the Washington Service Corps and funded by the federal AmeriCorps VISTA (Volunteers in Service to America) program. VISTA members commit to serve full-time for a year at a nonprofit organization or local government agency, working to fight illiteracy, improve health services, strengthen community groups, and much more. Members serve a full 12-month term of service, full-time, 40 hours a week. For the 2010-2011 program year, there are 20 VISTA positions located at 12 host sites across the state.
