- Includes all sentences, regardless of length

Of the 3,387 offenders who committed their offense between age 18 and 24:

- 19 have an LWOP
- 634 have a length of stay (Admit date to current ERD) of 20 months or less
- 123 offenders with a length of stay of 20 years or longer right now (current cohort)
- 28 offenders have served 19 years (approximate second cohort)
- 34 offenders have served 18 years (approximate third cohort)
