### IV. LEGISLATIVE BILL UPDATE

Chair Boerner discussed the racial and ethnic impact statement workgroup at the Caseload Forecast Council. Ed Vukich commented that there will be a meeting of the workgroup on Thursday (14<sup>th</sup>). Chair Boerner asked if any other members would like to be on the workgroup. He also asked Keri-Anne to make sure Judge Shaffer is informed about the workgroup.

Keri-Anne informed the members that the post-secondary education language was included in the striking amendment even though the bill itself did not pass (HB2619/SB6260).

Chair Boerner asked if members knew anything about the re-entry council. Keri-Anne noted that the SGC would not have a seat on the council, but that she thought members would be interested to know the council exists and that WSIPP will be completing a study.

Senator Roach suggested the SGC look into payments to offenders who participate in work programs. Dan Satterberg added that he would like to learn what programs are available at which institutions. Clela Steelhammer offered DOC to provide a presentation.
