6. Effect of ESSB 5891 and the 2011-13 Budget

On June 15, 2011, Governor Gregoire signed ESSB 5891 Related to criminal justice cost savings. This bill accompanied the signing of the 2011-13 budget. The SGC and SOPB were eliminated in its current form. ESSB 5891 places the policy functions of the SGC and SOPB under the Office of Financial Management. The SGC data, statistical summary reports and sentencing manual updates will move to the Caseload Forecast Council. Further details about the future of the SOPB will be discussed during the Board meeting.
