




Figure 7. Percentage Uninsured, Congressional Districts, 2018




Figure 8. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 1, 2012-18




Figure 9. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 2, 2012-18




Figure 10. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 3, 2012-18




Figure 11. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 4, 2012-18




Figure 12. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 5, 2012-18




Figure 13. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 6, 2012-18




Figure 14. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 7, 2012-18




Figure 15. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 8, 2012-18




Figure 16. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 9, 2012-18




Figure 17. Percentage Uninsured: Congressional District 10, 2012-18

Data Source and Notes

The original data source for this document is the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS) 1-year Public Use Microdata Sample file. The designation of congressional districts of the ACS records was performed using a crosswalk between congressional districts and Public Use Microdata Areas that are available in the ACS files. Previous reports used the crosswalk obtained from the Missouri Census Data Center's Geographic Correspondence Engine (http://mcdc.missouri.edu/websas/geocorr12.html). Starting from this report, the PUMA-congressional district crosswalk produced by OFM is used instead.

In working with the ACS data, OFM analysts uncovered a significant undercount of Medicaid enrollment in the ACS for Washington starting in 2014, the year the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) first rolled out the Medicaid expansion program. An adjustment was made to the 2014-18 ACS using administrative data from the Medicaid program to account for the undercount of Medicaid.

For this document, estimates for 2012-13 were calculated using unadjusted ACS data and estimates for 2014-18 were calculated using ACS data adjusted for Medicaid undercount.
