

Bill Number and Title <b>2ESSB 5034, AN ACT Relating to fiscal matters</b>
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This ten-year analysis is limited to the estimated revenue associated with the proposed fee increases in sections 136(1); 147; 148(2); 204(4)(a); 205(1)(b)(i); 206(4)(a); 208(3); 217(1); 219(2); 302(2); 309(2); 309(3); 603(2) through (9); 604(3) through (9); 612; 950(2); and 1401(4). Estimates for authorized fee increases are detailed below.

Some fees authorized in the sections identified above do not appear in the table for the following reasons:

There is no plan to raise fees as authorized in sections 148(2); 204(4)(a); 208(3), and 612.

Increases to the Reasonable Available Control Technology (RACT) assessments authorized in section 302(2) cannot be estimated. The Department of Ecology plans to work with stakeholders to develop a fee structure that fully recovers costs and distributes those costs fairly among clients. Multiple options exist for a fee structure and it is not known which one would be adopted. Furthermore, RACT assessments are infrequent and unpredictable. It is not known how many, if any, will be made over the next ten years.

Section 1401(4) authorizes the Washington State Patrol to increase the Notary Service Fee during Fiscal Year 2013. Due to the late authorization, it will not be possible to do the stakeholder work that is required to revise the Washington Administrative Code and implement the fee increase prior to June 30, 2013.
