This ten-year analysis is limited to the estimated revenue associated with the proposed fee increases. Increases in fees are authorized for boiler inspections and permits; plumber licensing, education and examination. Prevailing wage certification fee are increased from \$25 to \$40. The explosive license fee minimum range is authorized to go up from \$5-\$15 to \$25-\$50 and the maximum to go up from \$15-\$100 to \$100-\$400. Changes to the fee schedule and expiration dates are authorized for factory assembled structures and mobile/manufactured homes.

Fee increases are authorized to cover costs of federally required background checks for security guards and certification for real estate appraisers; allows increases in fees for licensing bail bond agents, agencies and recovery agents to pay for the cost of implementing ESSB6437; and allows for a new fee to pay for legislatively required skill testing for commercial driver licensing.
