SUBJECT: Chapter 10 - Travel

We have revised Chapter 10, Travel, in Washington's *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM). The modifications are effective July 1, 2010, and reflect the restrictions on travel for boards and commissions enacted by Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill (ESSHB) 2617, and additional restrictions for use of private facilities by state agencies.

Chapter 10: Travel (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/10.htm)

- Modified Subsection 10.10.55 to require agencies to have additional approval for holding
 meetings in private facilities. For executive branch agencies, additional information and the

- Created new Subsection 10.70.00 to reflect the travel restrictions contained in ESSHB 2617.
