## SUBJECT: REIMBURSEMENT RATES FOR LODGING AND MEALS

We have revised Chapter 10, <u>Travel</u>, of the *State Administrative & Accounting Manual* (SAAM). As a result of changes adopted by the U.S. General Services Administration, we modified the maximum allowable lodging and meal rates for several Washington state locations. This change is effective October 1, 2010. Refer to SAAM Subsection <u>10.90.20</u>.
