
Figure 1 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2011	3



Figure 1 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2011





Figure 2 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2012







Figure 4 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2014





Figure 5 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2015





Figure 6 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2016





Figure 7 - County Uninsured Rates (percent), 2017






Figure 9 - Percent Uninsured, Asotin County, 2011-17


Figure 10 - Percent Uninsured, Benton County, 2011-17


Figure 11 - Percent Uninsured, Chelan County, 2011-17


Figure 12 - Percent Uninsured, Clallam County, 2011-17


Figure 13 - Percent Uninsured, Clark County, 2011-17


Figure 14 - Percent Uninsured, Columbia County, 2011-17


Figure 15 - Percent Uninsured, Cowlitz County, 2011-17


Figure 16 - Percent Uninsured, Douglas County, 2011-17


Figure 17 - Percent Uninsured, Ferry County, 2011-17


Figure 18 - Percent Uninsured, Franklin County, 2011-17


Figure 19 - Percent Uninsured, Garfield County, 2011-17


Figure 20 - Percent Uninsured, Grant County, 2011-17


Figure 21 - Percent Uninsured, Grays Harbor County, 2011-17


Figure 22 - Percent Uninsured, Island County, 2011-17


Figure 23 - Percent Uninsured, Jefferson County, 2011-17


Figure 24 - Percent Uninsured, King County, 2011-17


Figure 25 - Percent Uninsured, Kitsap County, 2011-17


Figure 26 - Percent Uninsured, Kittitas County, 2011-17


Figure 27 - Percent Uninsured, Klickitat County, 2011-17


Figure 28 - Percent Uninsured, Lewis County, 2011-17


Figure 29 - Percent Uninsured, Lincoln County, 2011-17


Figure 30 - Percent Uninsured, Mason County, 2011-17




Figure 32 - Percent Uninsured, Pacific County, 2011-17


Figure 33 - Percent Uninsured, Pend Oreille County, 2011-17


Figure 34 - Percent Uninsured, Pierce County, 2011-17


Figure 35 - Percent Uninsured, San Juan County, 2011-17


Figure 36 - Percent Uninsured, Skagit County, 2011-17


Figure 37 - Percent Uninsured, Skamania County, 2011-17


Figure 38 - Percent Uninsured, Snohomish County, 2011-17


Figure 39 - Percent Uninsured, Spokane County, 2011-17


Figure 40 - Percent Uninsured, Stevens County, 2011-17


Figure 41 - Percent Uninsured, Thurston County, 2011-17


Figure 42 - Percent Uninsured, Wahkiakum County, 2011-17


Figure 43 - Percent Uninsured, Walla Walla County, 2011-17




Figure 45 - Percent Uninsured, Whitman County, 2011-17

Data Sources and Notes

The original data source for this document is the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey 1-year Public Use Microdata Sample file. The Washington State Office Financial Management (OFM) used the American Community Survey (ACS) data, along with other population data from the OFM, as input to its County Population Estimation Model (CPEM) to produce the county-level health insurance coverage estimates.

In working with the ACS data, OFM analysts uncovered a significant undercount of Medicaid enrollment in Washington starting in 2014, the year the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act first rolled out Medicaid expansion program. A decision was made to adjust for the undercount of Medicaid in the 2014-17 ACS using administrative data from the Medicaid program before the ACS data were used in the CPEM.

For this document, the statewide estimates were calculated using the ACS 1-year PUMS for 2011-13 and the adjusted ACS for 2014-17. The county-level estimates were calculated using the Office of Financial Management CPEM.
