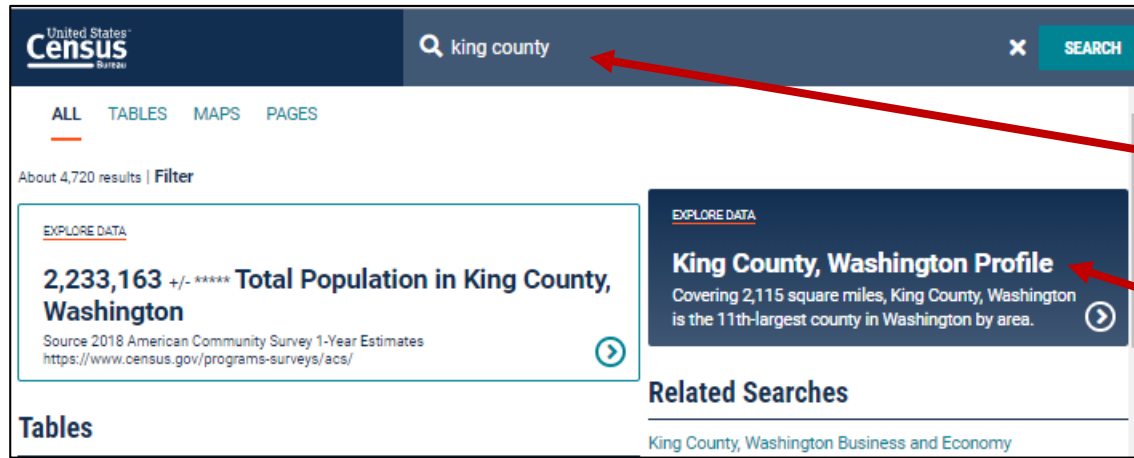

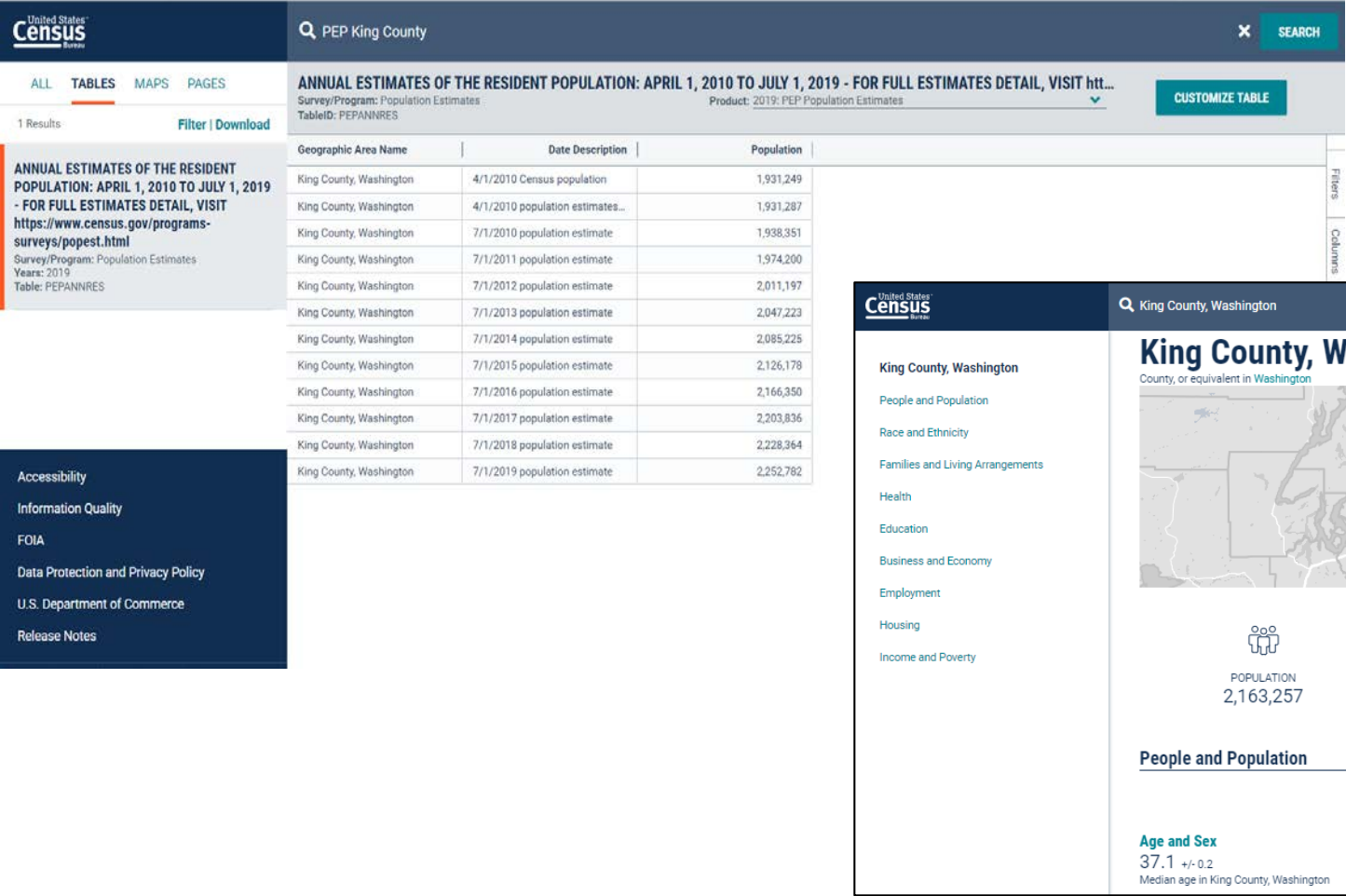

Transition from DataFerrett

Since we are a developing site, not all the data from DataFerrett have been migrated over to [Microdata Access](https://data.census.gov). 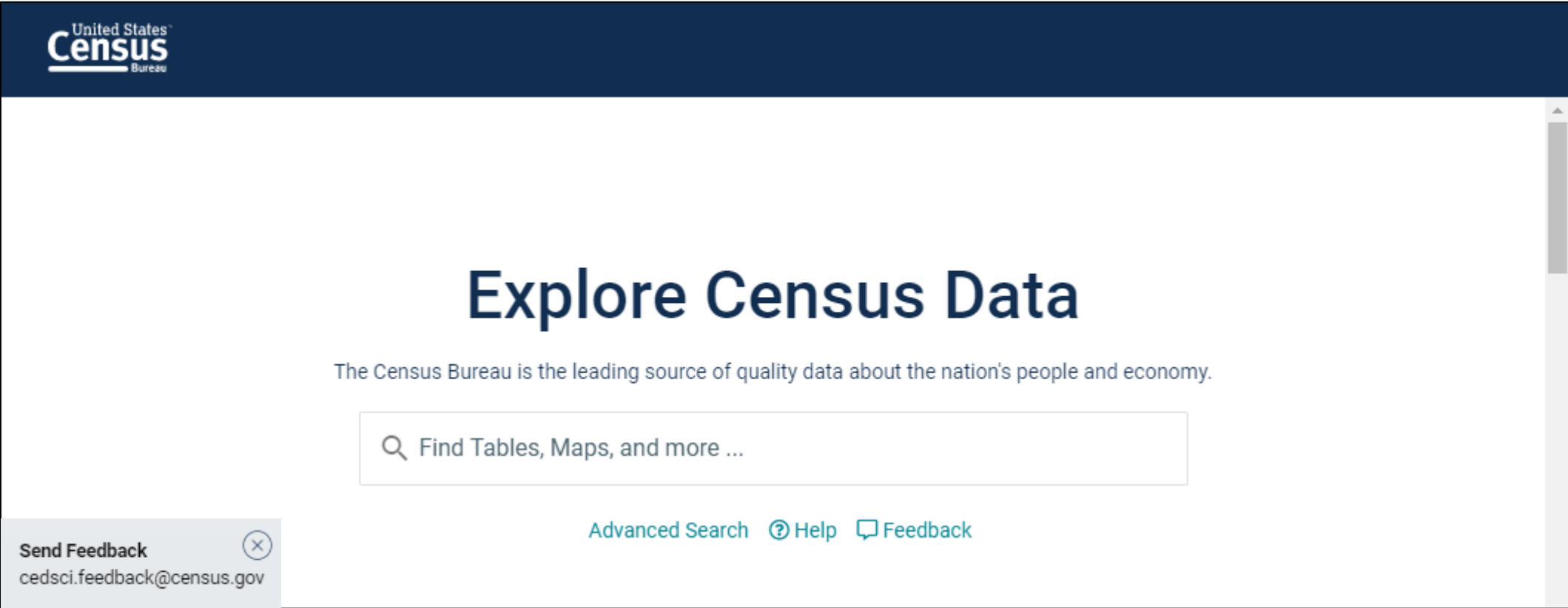
