

FPMT Password Reset

This job aid explains how to reset your FPMT account password.

- ✓ Please use Chrome or Firefox as your browser. Do not use Internet Explorer or Edge.
- ✓ Passwords expire per OCIO guidelines and will need to be reset according to the instructions below.
- ✓ Users may change their passwords before expiration by going to the My User Account module in FPMT.
- ✓ If you try to log in with an expired or incorrect password multiple times, your account will be locked.




Click the **Reset Password** hyperlink.



The **Reset Password** screen appears, as shown. Enter your email address and click **SUBMIT**.




The **Reset Password – Security Question** screen appears. Enter your answer and click **SUBMIT**.

Follow the instructions in the email regarding logging in with your temporary password.


When you sign in, you will be required to:
